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Vsebina:	Content (Syllabus outline):
Razloženi bodo zgodovina, družbeni kontekst in pomen prostorskega obrata v humanistiki in družboslovju. Po sodobnem razumevanju je prostor ontološko večplasten, dinamičen in družbeno proizveden. Iz te perspektive bo orisana zgodovina razmerij med geografijo in literarno vedo, vključno z razvojem literarnih zemljevidov. Osrednji del predavanj bo posvečen literarni geografiji in kartiranju (zlasti tistemu s pomočjo geografskih informacijskih sistemov) kot analitični metodi za zgodovinsko obravnavo tem, form, žanrov in družbenega življenja književnosti, pa tudi odnosov med literaturami. Natančneje bodo predstavljene raziskave prostora slovenske književnosti.	This course explains the history, social context, and importance of the spatial turn in the humanities and social sciences. According to modern conceptions, spaces are ontologically multilayered, dynamic, and socially produced. This perspective forms the basis for outlining the history of the relationships between geography and literary studies, including the development of literary maps. The main part of the lectures focuses on literary geography and cartography (especially using geographic information systems) as an analytical method for the historical treatment of topics, forms, genres, and the social life of literatures, as well as relations between literatures. Research on the Slovenian

	literature environment is presented in greater detail.

**Cilji in kompetence:**

Slušateljice in slušatelji se seznanijo z vlogo prostorskega obrata v menjavah paradigm in smeri sodobne humanistike in spoznajo, v čem so nove koncepcije razmerja med prostorom in kulturnimi praksami pomembne za literarno zgodovino (nacionalno in primerjalno). Spoznajo zgodovino interakcij med geoprostorom in literaturo kot prostorsko prakso. Seznanijo se z zgodovino literarnega kartiranja, s strukturo tematskih kart in se naučijo uporabljati GIS-e v analizah literarnega sistema.

**Objectives and competences:**

Students are introduced to the role of the spatial turn in paradigm changes and the modern humanities, and learn what makes the new conceptions of the relationship between spaces and cultural practices important for (national and comparative) literary history. They familiarize themselves with the history of interactions between geographical space and literature as a spatial practice, the history of literary cartography, and the structure of thematic maps, and they learn to use GIS in literary system analyses.

**Predvideni študijski rezultati:**

Slušatelji in slušateljice znanje, pridobljeno pri predmetu, uporabijo pri pisanju znanstvenega teksta, ki lahko služi kot osnutek poglavja disertacije ali znanstvenega članka.

**Intended learning outcomes:**

Students use the knowledge acquired in the course to write a piece of academic writing that can serve as a draft of a dissertation chapter or a research article.
