Cilji in kompetence:

Sklop predavanj in seminarjev bo posvečen spoznavanju in razumevanju pomena nemškega idealizma tako za zgodovino filozofije in njen nadaljnji razvoj kot tudi za razumevanje razmerja filozofije do znanosti, umetnosti, politike in ljubezni. Študentke in študenti bodo v okviru tega predmeta spoznali, kako je zasnova prve resnične metafizike (Kant) presegla ne le dotedanjo dogmatično metafiziko, marveč tudi revolucionirala mišljenje kot tako.

Predmet ima tri cilje:

1. pojasniti novost kantovske kopernikanske revolucije v filozofiji in rešitve, ki jih prinaša za probleme tradicionalne dogmatične metafizike;
2. pojasniti pomen revolucije v mišljenju, ki jo prinaša kantovske kopernikanske revolucije v filozofiji; pojasniti implikacije in nasledke te revolucije ne le v filozofiji, pač pa tudi v razumevanju politike, umetnosti, ljubezni in znanosti;
3. obravnavati naš čas iz perspektive Kantove, Heglove, Fichtejeve in Schellingove filozofije. Predavanja bodo pri tem izhajala iz francoske revolucije kot ključnega političnega dogodka v času nemškega idealizma in ga navezali na zgodovino spodletelih revolucij in njihovih posledic v 20. stoletju.

Predavanja in seminarji v okviru tega predmeta bodo omogočila študentom in študentkam razumeti, kako je mogoče, opirajoč se na filozofijo Kanta, Schellinga, Fichteja in Hegla, misliti politične in umetniške pogoje današnje družbene situacije. Namen tega predmeta je pokazati, kako ima lahko neki specifičen trenutek v zgodovini filozofije daljnosežne posledice za ustvarjanje pogojev možnosti in nadljanji razvoj mišljenja kot takega.

Objectives and competences:

At its beginning and in its own self-description what is commonly referred to as German Idealism claimed to be the first real metaphysics ever consistently developed in the history of philosophy. In this way Kant thought to have embarked on a journey whose end will finally overcome traditional dogmatic metaphysics as well as the scepticism (toward metaphysics) it provoked. Just two and a half decades later, Hegel will already announce the end, not only of (this new kind of) philosophy, but also of politics, art and history. What has been called the "25 years of philosophy" (E. Förster), that is "German Idealism" marks one of the liveliest, yet also densest and most convoluted moments in the history of philosophy. This course will introduce into the thought and the contemporary relevance of the thinkers that belong to the philosophical tradition of German Idealism (mainly Kant, Fichte, Schelling and Hegel). It will have a threefold objective:

1. To introduce and discuss by recourse to the enlisted philosophers what was lacking (or not) in the philosophies before Kant and raise the question of what changed with the so called Copernican Revolution in philosophy and its aftermath.
2. To introduce and discuss in detail the implications and consequences that one the most crucial revolutions in the history of philosophy had not only for philosophy but also for understanding politics, art, love and science.
3. To raise the question not if there is anything meaningful for us to find in Kant, Hegel, Fichte or Schelling, but rather how do conceive of our contemporary situation from the respective perspective of these thinkers. This will be done by focussing inter alia on the reception of the political Ur-event of the time of German Idealism, namely the French Revolution, and by relating it

to the history of failed revolutions and their outcome in the 20th century. Students will learn in these lecture classes, what it means or can mean to think about their own present situation and the present political and artistic condition with Hegel, Kant et al. This will be done by showing how and why what appears to be a mere particular moment in the history of an academic discipline ultimately has far reaching and transformative repercussions on the very condition of possibility of thought as such.
