**Cilji in kompetence:**

Predmet obravnava vprašanja spomina in zgodovine skozi tehnologije posredovanja preteklosti v medijskih okoljih. Pri tem osrednje mesto namenja individualnim in vsakdanjim spominskim praksam v času nenehne povezljivosti (s poudarkom na Jugo-vzhodni Evropi), hkrati pa ponuja širši zgodovinski okvir vznika, uveljavitve in prevlade različnih medijskih tehnologij in posledic na razvoj in delovanje družbe in kulture.

Študentke in študentje spoznajo osnovne paradigmе medijskih študij, medijske arheologije, zgodovine tehnologije in pridobivanje znanje in orodja za prepoznavanje in vrednotenje različnih virov v interpretaciji preteklosti. Skozi analizo tehnoloških vidikov ter avdiovizualnih in besedilnih medijskih vsebin, predmet ponuja analitični okvir za raziskovanje in razumevanje širših zgodovinskih, družbenih in kulturnih vidikov bivanja v medijsko posredovani družbi.

**Objectives and competences:**

The course covers topics of memory and history in through technologies of mediating the past in media environments. It focuses on individual and collective memory practices in the time of ubiquitous connectivity (with emphasis on South-eastern Europe). It offers a historical background to the emergence, development and domination of different media technologies and their influence on development of society and culture. The course offers an introduction to media studies, media archaeology, history of technology and equips the student with skills and competences to detect and reflect upon different sources in the interpretation of the past. Through the analysis of technological aspects and audiovisual and textual content, the course presents an analytical framework for researching and understanding wider historical, social and cultural aspects of being in mediated society.
